# Conditions of Entry

1. This entry covers the boat named. Any changes must be notified and agreed with Black Country Boating Festivals Limited prior to the event. No refunds will be made for cancellation or non-attendance.
2. Black Country Boating Festivals Limited reserves the right to refuse any entry.
3. Third party insurance with an indemnity minimum of £1,000,000 (One million pounds) must be held.
4. A current Canal and River Trust Boat Licence for the boat must be correctly displayed.
5. Toilets must not be discharged into the waterway.
6. Moorings are at the absolute discretion of Black Country Boating Festivals Limited and may be changed at any time. Black Country Boating Festivals Limited reserve the right to move any boat from the moorings prior to and/or during the festival should the need arise.
7. Trading, Marketing or Demonstration to the public is not permitted.
8. The running of generators or engines is only allowed between 8am and 8pm and should be limited to a maximum of 90 minutes in any 4 hour period.
9. Black Country Boating Festivals Limited cannot be held responsible for any damage to persons or property however caused.
10. Information provided will be stored in accordance with the General Data Protection Regulation (GDPR) for management of the event and promotion of future events.
