6. Moorings are at the absolute discretion of Black Country Boating Festivals Limited and may be changed at any time. Black Country Boating Festivals Limited reserve the right to move any boat from the moorings prior to and/or during the festival should the need arise.
7. Black Country Boating Festivals Limited cannot be held responsible for any damage to persons or property however caused.
